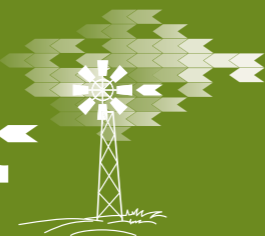

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in the closed, original container in a cool, well-ventilated area. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Do not store near food, feedstuffs, fertilisers or seed.

### 20L pack sizes

Triple rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on-site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and deliver empty packaging to an approved waste management facility. If an approved waste management facility is not available bury the empty packaging 500 mm below the surface in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots, in compliance with relevant Local, State or Territory government regulations. Do not burn empty containers or product.

### For refillable containers (110 L and 1000 L pack sizes)

Empty contents fully into application equipment. Close all valves and return to point of supply/designated collection point/other specific collection details for refill or storage.

### SMALL SPILL MANAGEMENT

Wear protective equipment (See SAFETY DIRECTIONS). Apply absorbent material such as earth, sand, clay granules or cat litter to the spill. Sweep up material for disposal when absorption is completed and contain in a refuse vessel for disposal (See STORAGE AND DISPOSAL section). If necessary wash the spill area with an alkali detergent and water and absorb, as above, the wash liquid for

disposal as described above.

### SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Harmful if swallowed. Will attack eyes and will irritate the skin. Repeated exposure may cause allergic disorders. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. If product in eyes, wash it out immediately with water. DO NOT inhale spray mist. When preparing the spray and using the prepared spray wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist and a washable hat, elbow length PVC gloves and goggles. After use and before eating, drinking or smoking, wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. After each day's use, wash gloves, goggles and contaminated clothing.
